

AFD Fully Committed to Supporting DOS Users

ollowing the news that other address management companies were withdrawing support for some MS-DOS users, we confirm that our Postcode and Postcode Plus ranges will continue to support DOS systems well into the future.

Sympathising with businesses let down by the withdrawal of support for MS-DOS, AFD have agreed to deduct the Royal Mail licence fee from the price paid for a Postcode product by anyone who has a current non-AFD Address Management product license.

This agreement will assist customers who want to continue developing and using their DOS based systems by allowing them to upgrade easily to an AFD Postcode product.

AFD is committed to offering support and product development for users of DOS systems – in Postcode News 9 we announced the release of the significant new support for DOS systems from Postcode Plus.

Postcode Plus for DOS is a command-line program that provides access to all the features of the Postcode Plus engine, for developers who are working in languages like 'C', Basic, Clipper, Fox – in fact anything which can run an external program then read a text file.

Postcode Plus Speeds Up Enquiries for the British Epilepsy Association

Our user story this issue comes from the British Epilepsy Association, who use Postcode Plus and Postcode Provider to help improve services.

Epilepsy is probably the most misunderstood neurological condition in the UK today. Often surrounded by fear, prejudice and old wives tales, the condition affects one in about every 130 people in the UK. The British Epilepsy Association was founded to help improve the lives of people with epilepsy in an often ignorant wider community.

As needs have grown, the Association's services have grown. With 20,000 members and nearly 40,000 people using the Association's free phone helpline, rapid and accurate address handling is vital.

Postcode products are being used to help the Association provide a better service to members and callers and, in the process, to help it save time and money. Barry Wilson, the IT Support Officer, has used the opportunity of a change of database to introduce address management into the Association's working practices.

One area where time savings using Postcode Plus have generated measurable money savings is the Association's Helpline. The Helpline uses an 0800 number, with the

Association paying for the call. This is to encourage people with epilepsy, whose incomes may be small, to have the confidence to contact the Association for advice and help without financial penalty.

Here, using Postcode Plus allows the Association to reduce the time callers spend giving basic information like their address. This time reduction means that more time can be spent on helping callers with their enquiry or problem.

As Barry Wilson said, 'If we can speed up the simple enquiries, then we can give more time and resource to people with epilepsy, their families and supporters. Using Postcode Plus helps us speed up enquiries, taking an address down by hand could be the longest part of a call. Addresses then had to be keyed after the call which used more time. Now we just key directly to the database. We also use the system in reverse as a look-up to find people who have called us before so we can track their contact with us.'

Postcode Provider is also used to keep data clean and in a common format. The Association runs a 15 user database package, 'Progress', through a netware server.



Postcode Changes

Il products in the Windows version of AFD's Postcode range now detect postcodes which have recently changed – and automatically provide the new postcode. Over the past few years, Royal Mainhave recoded several areas – like Bristol and parts of Sheffield recently – but it can take a long time before the replacement postcodes are used, and databases updated.

The ability to identify and replace a postcode from a recoded area is a very major improvement to Postcode products. For example, it further increases the processing speed of Postcode Provider and significantly increases the number of records matched, because a previously correct postcode can be verified and changed rather than searching for the postcode from the address elements.

This significant new change is provided free of charge with the Q.4/94 update and all program shipping after 26 December 1997. Order your update today and take advantage of faster processing speeds and improved yields.

A new API function provides this facility for use by developers – and our programming examples have been updated to show how.


