As part of this mammoth project, a review of

databases, accessed through the popular database program Access '97, MTS needed a simple and effective method of entering and managing their addresses.

In one database, customer technical support information is held, generated from householders with Ariston heating installations. A second database holds details of service centres and individual service engineers.

Postcodes are the key to identifying individuals within either database, and are used as a simple reference point when customers call in seeking guarantee information, or where to find an approved service centre. Kevin Ogilvie, MTS's Technical Manager, explained one use of Postcode Plus – to access local service engineers in cases of a breakdown to a customer's heating system, 'If your heating has broken down, you want it repaired urgently, if not sooner. By taking you postcode and matching it to our approved service centre's database, we can quickly locate the nearest approved service engineer and get someone sent to your home'.

The MTS team use Postcode products across a broad range of tasks to speed up and simplify their address handling.
