CompuServe is probably the best known paid-for Internet Service Provider in Europe. As well as the normal email and web access, members receive a comprehensive range of value added online services. These services are exclusive and often have a proprietary content which is only available via CompuServe.

As Internet use explodes, CompuServe is signing up hundreds of new members daily. Members sign up by post or online. With sign ups taking place at this rate, it's no surprise to hear that CompuServe use fully integrated

address management technology to validate their addresses.

Postcode Plus has been seamlessly integrated into the host services section of CompuServe's sign-up systems. Whatever route a new member uses, whether post or via the on-line automated sign-up, their address is automatically verified using sub-routines which link to Postcode Plus.

Rich Browne, IT Manager, explains, 'We validate the addresses of all UK customers paying by direct debit using Postcode Plus, before adding them to our member databases.

Our automated on-line application system automatically links back to our host services section, where Plus is held, and checks address files against those in Plus. Neither members nor our operators see the address check up routine taking place.

The on-line member sign-up is a pretty sophisticated piece of programming which allows rapid processing of new member applications. By integrating a range of support programs like Postcode Plus in the sign-up system, we can make joining CompuServe quick and easy for the customer, whilst giving us valid and accurate address and other data.'



callers to the location of their nearest branch? Need to allocate the nearest specialist – or even the nearest pizza outlet? Well, the Nearest function, always included in Postcode Plus, has just been significantly enhanced... and is now delivered as part of Names & Numbers V2 and Postcode Plus V5.

To build a "Nearest" list from scratch or select or query an existing database is easy. Multiple databases and user defined formats are supported. Each database field can be labelled and a field can be filtered. For example, a field may identify burger bars as either 'drive through', 'licensed' or 'large party bookings'. This field could be filtered to select only (say) 'drive through'



HOT SPot Professor Postcode –

AFD's own problem solver

he Prof answers your questions on address management.

'I work for a small company. I'm totally fed up with having to check addresses manually and then type them into our computer system. A friend's firm uses Postcode and she says its great. I've asked my boss for a copy, but he can't see the point. How could I show him Postcode would be worth our while?'



On average, a person in your type of job earns about £6.50 an hour. We've calculated that by using Postcode, your efficiency can be increased by a minimum of 10%. That gives a saving of 65 pence per hour. If you work for 20 hours a week on address related tasks then, by your increased efficiency, the business will be saving £13.00 per week/£52.00 per month. You'll also be saving up to 80% of keystrokes as well.

Now let's look at duplicates. You're probably the person who has to deal with customers who have received 5 copies of the same item – all with tiny differences in the address.

By referring to Postcode's accurate addresses, it is much easier to pick out these incorrectly addressed duplicates for removal from your mailing list. And every duplicate that you remove saves cash. An average



mailing list of 10,000 even just 1% duplicated addresses wastes £167.00.

Nothing upsets customers more than having their address wrongly spelt - especially if they have spent ages spelling it all out. With Postcode, all you have to do is take their postcode, name and house number. Postcode automatically generates postally accurate addresses, saving time and money and giving your company an efficient and helpful image.

And if you're using a freephone or low cost line to take enquiries, you'll soon make significant savings on call costs. It all adds up doesn't it? I'm sure that once you have shown your boss just how effective address management can be, he'll be ordering Postcode for you, especially as the program only costs £15 (inc. vat) per month under the AFD POP scheme.
