



Lightning fast searches, breadth of data and ease of integration are just three of the reasons given by users for choosing AFD Postcode Plus for address management.

The January release Q.1/03 provides many important new features to users:

GIS & Navigation-Ready

AFD's Postcode Plus software now has a special function that converts the Postcode Plus grid references to longitude and latitude co-ordinates.

"Many organisations want to integrate the tracking of assets such as vehicles / equipment and staff with route planning and other systems to improve productivity, cut administration and increase customer service. Postal addresses need longitude latitude co-ordinates to link effectively with GPS (Global Positioning System) and other mapping technologies. By including these special conversion functions with Postcode Plus, it's now even easier to plot addresses on maps and use them within GIS systems."

This enhanced feature is also available to programmers through the use of the AFD Utility DLL. For full implementation details see the API programmers guide: http://www.afd.co.uk/pcpman/

Using "Alias Localities" to find addresses

Postcode Plus now contains the local names (Alias Localities) by which many areas are known. These names are not part of an official PAF* postal address... however, including them with Postcode Plus brings significant benefits to different users. Where a postcode and / or town name is missing but an Alias Locality name is available it is often possible to identify the correct, fully postcoded address.

When postcodes are missing and the address occurs more than once an Alias Locality can help to identify which of the options is correct.

Example

7 Bridge Road, London occurs four times.

Using the Alias Locality "Walthamstow" narrows to just one possible match E17 8HG.

For local and historic reasons locality names are often referred to by members of the public seeking advice or using local government, health or emergency services. The Alias-Locality searching in Postcode Plus now helps quickly identify the correct address, and deliver the product or service efficiently.

Alias Locality Facts & Recommendations.

Alias Locality information is presented at "Sector Level" and is therefore not precise. Around 70% of Postcode Sectors list at least one Alias Locality - whilst some have over 100 different possibilities.

Alias Locality information is of most value when searching for a full address and accurate postcode. Selecting and saving Alias Locality information should only be done with great care... and we don't recommend it. Royal Mail do not guarantee that Alias information is either comprehensive or fully accurate.

Full "Fast Find" for Robot

AFD address entry solutions install with a clever Robot which waits for you to type a Postcode, then looks up the address and offers to complete it. Robot knows which program you are using and sets out the address appropriately.

The Robot has now been upgraded so that you don't even need to know the Postcode for Postcode Plus or Names & Numbers to look up the address.

For example just type: #AFDS#

into a Microsoft Word document and a pick-list showing all the address options for AFD Software Ltd will appear.

Click on the required address and it is instantly inserted into the document. The same applies in almost any other Windows program.



Compact Mode

After listening to our users we have decided to introduce the popular "compact mode" (first introduced in AFD Postcode) to Postcode Plus. This mode uses less screen space and allows users to keep the Postcode Plus entry screen visible whilst working with other applications. It also lets the user do "fast finds" and easy "insert" operations with less clutter.



Automatic Program Detection

A new feature, introduced across the AFD range in Q.1/03 releases, means that the program will now default to inserting the address into the program you were last using. Particularly useful when used in conjunction with the Hotkey feature. For instance:- If you are typing a document in Word and need an address.

Pressing the Hotkey to activate your AFD program Type the postcode - it will be looked automatically. Press F2 to insert it into Word.

Switch to another program - like Excel and Pop up AFD, and the address you want is inserted back to Excel. No configurations to change, no options to choose.
