Operating since October 1994, they now have a rapidly growing client base of over 14,000 customers. Customers that range

from the home user to large corporate clients.

James Roskell, Sales Team Leader at U-NET, describes their use of Postcode –

"Our large sales database is currently on a network of 10 machines and the Sales Team takes calls for further information and orders all day – every day.

Previously, addresses were being entered manually. As U-NET grew and the number of calls were increasing, this was becoming time consuming and errors were creeping in. Our Internet systems run 24 hours a day, 7 days a week 365 days a year, so a typo made in seconds can take 10-15 minutes to fix, which really annoys the customer.

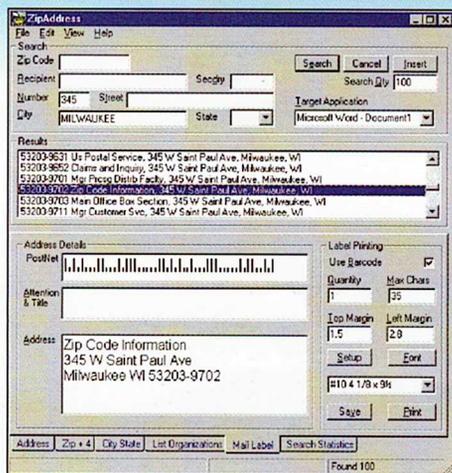
The decision was made to purchase and implement a postcode database at the end of 1996, and in November, we ordered AFD Postcode.

The CD supplied was quick and easy to install and with the helpful examples supplied, we were able to implement it into our existing database forms within an afternoon. The amount of time and effort it saves us probably paid for the software within the first 2 months. It frightens our customers sometimes when they cannot remember their full address or postcode and before they can, we've told them!

ZipAddress runs on either Windows '95 or Windows NT.

Single user ZipAddress costs just £35.00 + VAT & carriage. The Network Version supporting up to 20 users is £350.00 +VAT & carriage and an unlimited user Company Licence is £3,500 + VAT & carriage. Each data set lasts approximately 6 months, and data updates are available at just £20 + VAT each. ZipAddress will start shipping to numerous UK and US customers on 26th September 1997.

System requirements are 8Mb RAM, Windows 95 or 16 Mb RAM Windows NT. A minimum of 8Mb hard disk space (running from CD) or a maximum of 500Mb when installed on hard disk.

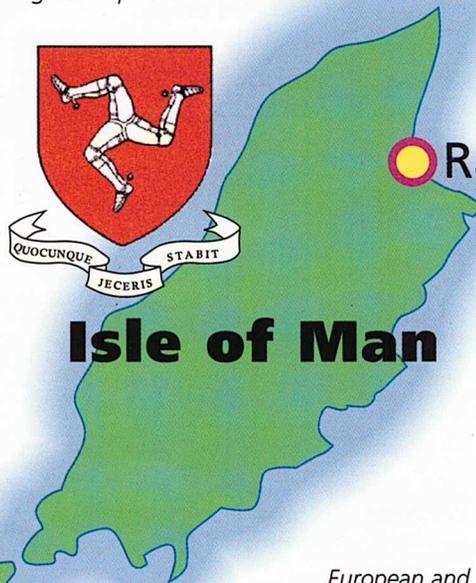

spend less time on hold or waiting in queues.'

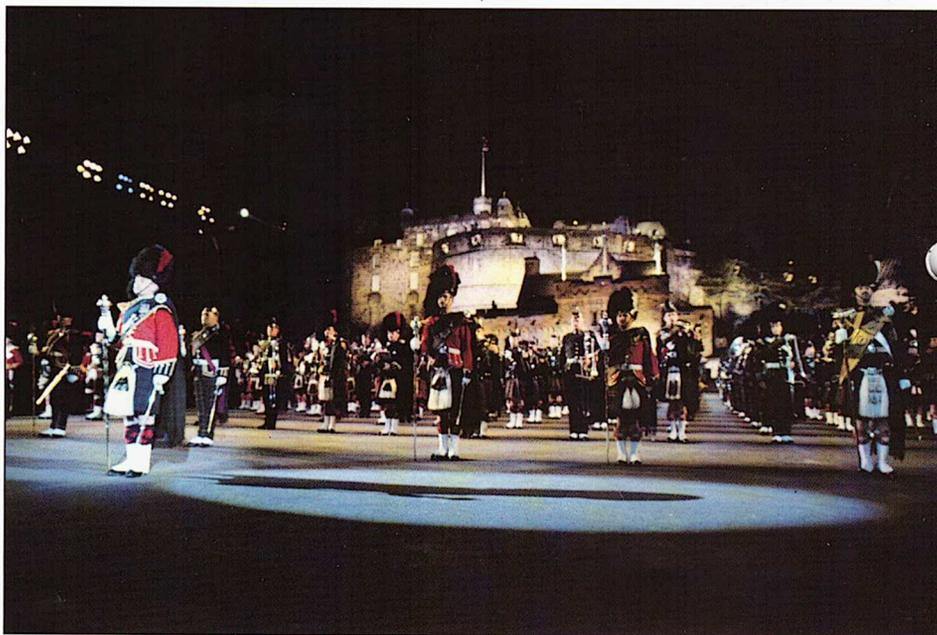

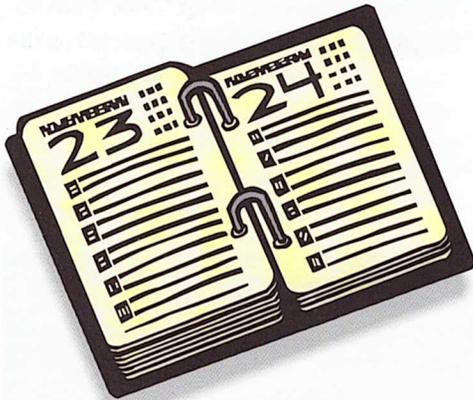

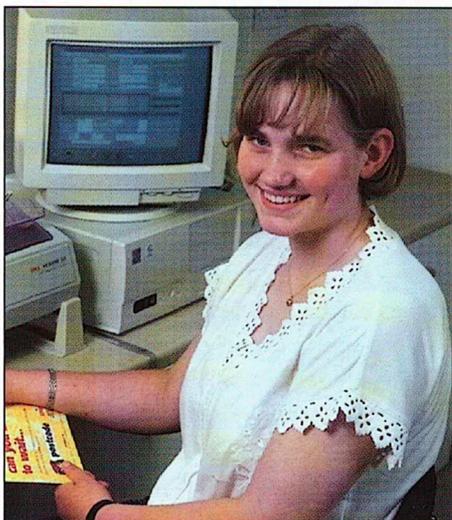
